Identification will be required at this appointment for prescription purposes.

It is very important for you to follow these instructions.

1. *You must not eat anything after midnight the night before surgery.* You may have clear fluids up to 4 hours prior to your surgical appointment. Clear fluids include water, apple juice or ginger ale.
2. If you are taking medications, please bring the names, dosages, and the drug bottles with you, so that the drugs may be identified. Please ensure that a complete list of all medications and dosages is provided prior to treatment. A drug store printout summary is ideal.
3. *Continue taking prescription medications with a sip of water unless your surgeon has asked you to stop. Please confirm this with our office.*
4. Your judgement and reflexes may be impaired following sedation or anaesthetic. Although you may feel fully alert, *you must make arrangements for an adult to take you home following surgery and to be with you for the remainder of the day.*
5. *Please have your driver remain in the office while you are undergoing treatment.*
6. You must not operate a vehicle, power tools, or any machinery for the remainder of the day following sedation or general anaesthetic. Avoid tasks requiring co-ordination or judgement during this time. You are advised to avoid alcohol, and non-prescription medications including marijuana until the following day. If in doubt, please ask your surgeon.
7. If your health changes, or you develop a cold, flu or any (chest) respiratory disease during the week before surgery, please notify us immediately.
8. Please do not wear contact lenses on the day of surgery.
9. *Please wear an open neck, short sleeve shirt and no make-up, nail polish or jewellery.*
10. *Please notify us immediately if you suspect that you are pregnant.*
11. *Please notify us immediately if, for any reason, you are unable to keep your appointment.*
12. If you are scheduled for a general anaesthetic and have a family physician, please request a cumulative patient profile (C.P.P.) and have it sent to our office prior to the surgical date.
